TITLE 5: UNIFORM COMMERCIAL CODE DIVISION 2: SALES

§ 2703. Seller's Remedies in General.

Where the buyer wrongfully rejects or revokes acceptance of goods or fails to make a payment due on or before delivery or repudiates with respect to a part or the whole, then with respect to any goods directly affected and, if the breach is of the whole contract (5 CMC § 2612), then also with respect to the whole undelivered balance, the aggrieved seller may:

- (a) Withhold delivery of such goods;
- (b) Stop delivery by any bailee as hereafter provided (5 CMC § 2705);
- (c) Proceed under 5 CMC § 2704 respecting goods still unidentified to the contract;
 - (d) Resell and recover damages as hereafter provided (5 CMC § 2706);
- (e) Recover damages for non-acceptance (5 CMC § 2708) or in a proper case the price (5 CMC § 2709);
 - (f) Cancel.
