§ 10702. Notification duty of firearm owners.

- (a) Every person or organization has a duty to report to the Department of Public Safety on a prescribed form within three business days:
 - (1) the loss, theft, or destruction of a firearm registered to him or her, including the circumstances, upon discovery of such loss, theft, or destruction; and
 - (2) when the firearm is transferred outside of the Commonwealth.
- (b) Failure to comply with this section is a civil infraction punishable by a fine of \$500.
