§ 1433. Mutiny on a Vessel.

- (a) A person commits an offense if, by force, threat of force, or deception, he or she usurps command of a vessel.
 - (b) A person convicted under this section may be punished:
 - (1) If the offense or attempt to commit the offense occurs on the high seas, by imprisonment for not more than five years;
 - (2) Otherwise, by imprisonment for not more than two years.
