

TITLE 6: CRIMES AND CRIMINAL PROCEDURE
DIVISION 2: CONTRABAND OFFENSES

§ 2402. Prohibited Acts.

(a) No person shall breathe, smell, inhale or ingest any product or substance containing a chemical material having the property of releasing toxic vapors or fumes, or the fumes or vapors thereof, for the purpose of inducing a condition of intoxication, stupefaction, depression, giddiness, euphoria, elation, or dulling the senses, or for the purpose of changing, distorting, or disturbing the audio, visual or mental processes.

(b) No person shall possess any product or substance containing a chemical material having the property of releasing toxic vapors or fumes with the intent of inducing a condition of intoxication, stupefaction, depression, giddiness, euphoria, elation or dulling the senses, or for the purpose of changing, distorting, or disturbing the audio, visual or mental processes.

(c) No person shall sell, offer for sale, transfer, distribute or deliver any product or substance containing a chemical material having the property of releasing toxic vapors or fumes to a person if the seller, offeror, transferor, distributor or deliverer knows or has reason to know that the person to whom the product or substance is being sold, offered, transferred, distributed, or delivered intends to induce a condition of intoxication, stupefaction, depression, giddiness, euphoria, elation or dulling the senses of himself or another, or intends to change, distort, or disturb his own or another's audio, visual or mental processes.
