§ 3177. Reasonable Distance.

Smoking is prohibited within a reasonable distance of 25 feet outside an enclosed area where smoking is prohibited, so as to insure that tobacco smoke does not enter the area through entrances, windows, ventilation systems, or other means. In no case shall this provision be used to apply or permit smoking on school or college property.
