§ 3304. Tampering with Judicial Records or Process.

Every person who willfully and unlawfully conceals, removes, takes away, mutilates, obliterates, alters (including the alteration of any document displaying the court seal or a copy of the court seal), or destroys, or attempts to do so, or willfully takes and carries away records or process in or from any court or official authorized to issue or serve the same, is guilty of tampering with judicial records or process, as the case may be, and upon conviction thereof, may be imprisoned for not more than five years, or fined not more than \$1,000, or both.
