TITLE 6: CRIMES AND CRIMINAL PROCEDURES DIVISION 3: MISCELLANEOUS OFFENSES

§ 3401. Possession or Removal of Government Property.

It is unlawful for any person, without proper authority, to have in his or her possession or remove from its location any property of any kind, wherever situated, of the government of the United States or of the Commonwealth government or its political subdivisions. Any person convicted of a violation of this section may be fined not more than \$100, or imprisoned not more than six months, or both.
