DIVISION 3: MISCELLANEOUS OFFENSES

§ 3606. Unlawful Manufacture, Sale, Distribution, Marking, Altering or Modification of Equipment and Devices Associated with Gaming.

(a) It is unlawful to manufacture, sell or distribute any cards, chips, dice, game or device which is intended to be used to violate any provision of this Article.

(b) It is unlawful to mark, alter or otherwise modify any associated equipment or gaming device which should be or is regulated by the Commission, in a manner that:

- (1) Affects the result of a wager by determining win or loss; or
- (2) Alters the normal criteria of random selection, which affects the operation of a game or which determines the outcome of a game.
