

TITLE 6: CRIMES AND CRIMINAL PROCEDURE
DIVISION 4: DISPOSITION OF OFFENDERS

§ 4117. Definitions.

As used in this chapter:

(a) “Crimes against the person” means any of the offenses described in title 6, division 1, part 1, chapters 1 through 4 [6 CMC § 1101 et seq.], and includes the attempt to commit any of those offenses.

(b) “Prisoner” or “parolee” means a person who has been convicted of a “crimes against the person.”

(c) “Victim” means the person who was the victim of the “crime against the person” for which the prisoner or parolee was convicted.
