§ 5114. Reports by Department.

When a juvenile offender has been committed to DYS pursuant to this chapter, DYS shall supply a report of the juvenile offender's educational and developmental progress to the committing court as often as the court deems necessary in its order of commitment, but not less frequently than every three months.
