§ 5115. Restitution to Victims of Juvenile Offenders – Duties of Department.

- (a) DYS probation shall make reasonable efforts to ensure that court ordered restitution is made to the victim of the juvenile offender. Restitution may be made through the employment of juvenile offenders in work programs or through other means.
 - (b) Restitution, where appropriate, shall be made a condition of probation.
