§ 5171. Records – Privileged Information.

(a) The court shall maintain records of all cases brought before it. In proceedings under this chapter, juvenile courtroom proceedings and records shall not be open to the public and shall remain confidential except upon order of the court.

(b) These records shall be open to inspection by the juvenile, the juvenile's parents while the juvenile remains a minor, DYS Juvenile Probation, the Family Court, AGO and any attorney representing the juvenile.
