§ 6906. Extradition of Persons Who Have Left Demanding State Involuntarily.

The Governor may also surrender on demand of the executive authority of any state any person in the Commonwealth who is charged, in the manner provided in 6 CMC § 6924, with having violated the laws of the state whose executive authority is making the demand, even though the person left the demanding state involuntarily.
