§ 6924. Fugitives from the Commonwealth: Applications for Requisition; Return of Person Charged With Crime.

When the return to the Commonwealth of a person charged with a crime in the Commonwealth is required, the Attorney General shall present to the Governor a written application for a requisition for the return of the person charged, in which application shall be stated the name of the person so charged, the crime charged, the approximate time, place and circumstances of its commission, the state in which the person is believed to be, including the location of the accused therein at the time the application is made, and certifying that, in the opinion of the Attorney General, the ends of justice require the arrest and return of the accused to the Commonwealth for trial, and that the proceeding is not instituted to enforce a private claim.
