§ 6931. Immunity From Other Criminal Prosecutions While in the Commonwealth.

After a person has been brought back to the Commonwealth by or after waiver of extradition proceedings, the person may be tried in the Commonwealth for other crimes which he or she may be charged with having committed in the Commonwealth as well as the crime specified in the requisition for extradition.
