§ 3106. Manner of Drawing Jurors.

(a) The names of jurors for an array shall be publicly drawn from a box containing the names of not less than 100 qualified persons at the time of each drawing. The jury box shall from time to time be refilled by the clerk of court or an assistant clerk of court and the Presiding Judge or any associate judge, designated by the Presiding Judge.

(b) The judge and the clerk or assistant clerk shall alternately place one name in the box until the box shall contain at least 100 names or such larger number as the court determines. The judge and the clerk or assistant clerk shall obtain these names in a manner approved by the court.
