§ 3305. Declaration Under Penalty of Perjury.

Whenever, under any law of the Commonwealth, any matter is required or permitted to be supported or proved by the sworn statement, declaration, verification, certification, oath, or affidavit in writing of the person making the same (other than a deposition, or an oath of office, or an oath required to be taken before a specified official other than a notary public), such matter may, with like force and effect be supported or proved by the unsworn declaration in writing of the person stating the date and place of execution within the Commonwealth and which is subscribed by the person and declared by the person to be true “under penalty of perjury,” which declaration may be in substantially the following form:

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct and that this declaration was executed on _____ at _____, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands.
