§ 2907. Carolinian Custom: Permanent Structures on Family Land.

No person shall construct, have constructed, or occupy a permanent structure on land held by a customary trustee without receiving prior approval to do so. Unless the family consents or agrees otherwise, prior approval shall be given only if the members of the family with title to use rights in the land consent to the proposed action.
