A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To repeal Rota Local Law 13-3, which imposed a complete ban on the exportation of Raw Bayogo from the island of Rota.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 SECTION 1. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE.

- The 23rd Rota Legislative Delegation finds that the imposition of a complete ban on
 Bayogo export from Rota has economically outgrown its purpose in making certain that the
 Bayogo from Rota is not exploited to enrich others by excluding Rota Bayogo crafts in the markets
 accessible to tourists. The ban has gone through several economic changes and actually became a
 detriment to the people of Rota by not having the opportunity to export raw Bayogo to sustain
 their livelihoods during economic crises in the CNMI.
- 8 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to repeal Rota Local Law 13-3 and lift the ban so that 9 people from Rota can begin to explore economic opportunities by either exporting raw Bayogo or 10 venturing into crafting and exporting their crafts through online marketing or other avenues.

HOUSE LOCAL BILL NO. 23-19

1 **SECTION 2. REPEALER.**

2 Rota Local Law 13-3, codified under Title 10, Division 1, Chapter 1, Article 4, of the 3 Commonwealth Code, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

4 **SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.**

5 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or 6 circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act 7 or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held 8 invalid shall not be affected thereby.

9 **SECTION 4. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

10 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing 11 right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation, or 12 order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding 13 instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of 14 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in 15 existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

16 **SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming law without 18 such approval.
