ORDER APPOINTING JUDGE PRO TEMPORE

¶1 Presiding Judge Robert C. Naraja has informed the Court that each of the sitting judges in the trial court has recused himself from the above-referenced matter. Under the authority of the NMI Const. art. § 9 and in furtherance of the prompt and efficient dispatch of Court business, the Chief Justice may designate a judge pro tempore as necessary.

¶2 THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

- a. The Honorable Maria T. Cenzon, Associate Judge of the Superior Court of Guam, is hereby designated and appointed to serve as Judge Pro Tempore in this matter.

- b. A party in this matter shall notify the Clerk of the Superior Court in writing no later than 15 days from the date of this ORDER of any good cause or reason why Judge Cenzone should not serve as Judge Pro Tempore in this case.

¶3 Unless good cause be shown otherwise, the Honorable Maria T. Cenzone shall have full authority to serve as Judge Pro Tempore in this matter and shall carry out the duties and powers inherent with the appointment.
